To Qualify, you must agree to fulfilling the following:

- 1) Commit to and attend the entire new class series, which take place between January and April, graduate as a TMN and certify either at that time or within the same calendar year.
- 2) Explain your need for financial assistance. (One page 2.)
- 3) Continue as a STBC-TMN Member **after** the classes are completed.
- 4) Fulfill your 40 hours of volunteer service, at your **DESIGNATED** volunteer site.

DESIGNATED VOLUNTEER SITE PREFERENCE: Please check one of the two volunteer sites below. If you are approved for a scholarship and site, your schedule will be coordinated through the Scholarship Committee prior to beginning your volunteer placement.

_____ **1) STBC-TMN Pollinator Garden** – Once a week watering, weed removal, etc. at the Chapter's garden site, located behind St. George Orthodox Church, where training classes and chapter meetings are held.

_____ **2) Vannie Cook Cancer Center for Children** – STBC-TMN Chapter Project – Once a week cleaning and refilling two hummingbird feeders located by the chemotherapy treatment room windows. The feeders are located outside the building and are accessible on any day and any time with a lock code that will be provided.
